Statewide Eviction Filing Data Now Available on Court System Website

NEW YORK—The New York State Unified Court System has launched an online Statewide Landlord-Tenant Eviction Dashboard, with eviction filing data from the New York City Civil Court and the City, District, and Town and Village Courts outside New York City now easily accessible to the public.

Among its features, the dashboard:

- Contains statewide eviction filing data from January 2019 to present, with data refreshed weekly.
- Summarizes case-level filing data into dynamic tables and graphs.
- Provides comparisons to U.S. census data used to identify rates of eviction proceeding-involved households in calculating New York State filings as a percentage of households in the country.
- Allows users to analyze data by year, month, county, court and other variables.
- Generates reports that provide a baseline of pre-pandemic filings.
- Enables users to identify trends and hot spots.

Developed in response to the high interest in eviction filing data from advocacy groups, the media and others—spurred by COVID-19 and the ensuing moratoriums on eviction filings—the dashboard is available at <https://ww2.nycourts.gov/lt-evictions-33576>.
