**Assistant Conflict Defender**

The Assistant Conflict Defender is a full time attorney position in the Conflict Defender's Office. Work involves providing legal representation to indigent clients throughout every stage of the proceedings from the initial arraignment through the conclusion of the case. Position requires appearances at criminal courts and off hour arraignments. The attorney also assists the Conflict Defender in the investigation, preparation, conduct, and appeal in various court and legal proceedings involving indigent defendants. Work is performed in accordance with guidelines provided in law. Does related work as required.

**Benefits:** Generous vacation and sick time allowance, Public Service Loan Forgiveness eligibility and the option to enroll in the St. Lawrence County's health insurance or opt out of the insurance and receive a buyout in the amount of \$2,000 for single coverage or \$4,000 for family.

**Minimum Qualifications:** Must be duly admitted to the New York State Bar and licensed to practice as an attorney in the State of New York.

The Conflict Defender's Office is located in Canton, New York, which is located in the northern region of the state. Part of the county is located within the Adirondacks and it's a short drive to Lake Placid, NY, which hosted the 1932 and 1980 Olympics. St. Lawrence County is close to Ottawa, Ontario, and Montreal, Quebec. The county is also home to St. Lawrence University, SUNY Canton, Clarkson University, SUNY Potsdam and the Crane School of Music, SUNY College of Environmental Science and Forestry's Ranger School.
