Employment will require occasional travel to handle matters on Long Island and the mid-Hudson. Other occasional travel within New York State may be required.

Applicants must reside in (or intend to seen become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that OAG attorneys be citizens of the United States. A two (2) year commitment upon being hired is a condition of employment.
