Hybrid Women's History Month Program to Celebrate Supreme Court Justice Sandra Day O'Connor's Legacy

MANHATTAN—In commemoration of Women's History Month, the Franklin H. Williams Judicial Commission, in collaboration with the New York Women Judges Association and the New York City Bar Association, is hosting a hybrid program on **Monday, March 18, at 6:00 p.m.** to celebrate the legacy of the late Supreme Court Justice Sandra Day O'Connor.

A panel discussion will include New York Court of Appeals Associate Judge Jenny Rivera (moderator) and panelists Hon. Eunice C. Lee, Circuit Judge for the U.S. Court of Appeals, Second Circuit; Bronx County District Attorney Darcel Clark; Julia A.
