Seeking Applications for Buffalo City Housing Court's Advisory Council

Play A Meaningful Role in Addressing Buffalo's Housing Challenges Application Deadline Extended to October 14, 2025

The Eighth Judicial District is seeking qualified candidates to serve as members of the Buffalo City Housing Court's Advisory Council, which makes recommendations to the District's Administrative Judge on matters related to the functioning of housing court, tenant-landlord disputes, and housing policy.

Appointed by the Eighth Judicial District Administrative Judge, the Mayor of Buffalo, and the District City Official, Council members will have the opportunity to propose, initiate, and develop supportive policy that benefits Buffalo's housing community and residents, contributing meaningfully to the Council's mission and the Buffalo community.

Candidates must be Erie County residents, at least 18 years of age, and committed to the Council's mission and objectives. In appointing the Council, two members must be representatives of the real estate industry; two of tenants' organizations; two of civic groups; two of bar associations; and four of the public at large.

The Council will meet at least four times a year, with the Administrative Judge having discretion to increase the frequency based on pending or urgent matters. The Council will submit reports of its findings and recommendations, including an annual report on Housing Court operations, for review by the Eighth Judicial District Administrative Judge and Mayor of Buffalo.

"Members of the Buffalo City Housing Court's Advisory Council play a vital role in shaping important housing policy in our great city. Our hope is that residents with industry knowledge will step forward to help realize the Council's mission in shaping policy that fosters continued improvement for our community, including our neighbors in greatest need. Being on the Council offers the opportunity to voice your opinions, engage meaningfully with your judiciary and community, and fulfill a much-needed civic duty," said Hon. Amy C.
